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"Handling 101: The Basics and Beyond" (using APHS* concepts and methodology)

This seminar is for experienced and new handlers alike. Whether you've never heard of APHS, have tried it a few times, or simply want to perfect your APHS handling skills, you'll get a lot out of this seminar!
