Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, participant/owner/auditor hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for, and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be or alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

### More about the AgilityVision facility:

Pictures and travel information can be found on the AgilityVision website. We do allow camping on site here but no RVs. There is a campground a little less than 2 miles down the road. It's important to note that we DO NOT have a fence around our agility field right now. We are located next to a road with a 35 mile an hour speed limit. Our agility ring is set back about 300 feet from the road. However, we don't recommend that you attend if you have a dog who chases cars. There is a big possibility we will have snow fencing on the ring perimeter of the ring the weekend of the seminar but if there's any doubt that your dog will chase cars please consider auditing instead. Barking dogs will need to be crated AWAY from the rings and in cars if possible. Since this seminar is being filmed any kind of excessive barking will ruin the audio. We have a right to ask you to move your dog if they are crated near the ring and barking.
