



**AgileDogs Agility Training  
CPE Trial – April 3-4, 2021  
High Goal Farm, Louse Hill Road, Greenwich, NY**

Thank you for entering our AgileDogs CPE trial at High Goal Farm! We need to make some changes to the normal trial routine and rules due to COVID-19. We know some of these rules may be inconvenient, they are all in place to protect your safety and that of your friends/family.

First, per state COVID requirements and club COVID guidelines:

- Covid Waivers must be signed and returned to the club secretary prior to the start of the trial or you will not be allowed to run. You may return them via email or send a picture of your signed waiver
- Masks are required to be able to run. No exceptions!

Other Covid rules for this trial:

- If you are sick please stay home.
- In order to minimize potential COVID-19 exposures and stay within NYS guidelines we are limiting attendance in the building at the trial to competitors only. In addition, we are requesting that, other than for purposes of entering or exiting the building to run with your dog, you arrange to enter or exit at the doorway nearest your parking space being careful not to make noise if a dog is running. Indoor seating with your dog will be allowed at this trial as long as social distancing is maintained. You must be at least 6 ft from your neighbor, the only exception being if you are attending with a spouse or family member. Please, no visiting with other participants while in the building! Also in order to keep everyone "masked up" in the building, no eating will be allowed in the building. Please plan to eat in your car. There will be no saving spaces and no spreading out your personal area inside the building. There will be no grouped lines of chair seating in front of the ring in the building. Indoor seating is on a first come, first served basis.
- Walk throughs will be split into groups based on height and level to minimize the number of people in the building at one time. In general, the plan is to combine levels 1 and 2 into one group when combined in games; when levels 345C run together, we will split by heights, small dogs (4/8/12"), Tall dogs, (16/20/24) This will be modified based on numbers in each class. We would like no more than 15 people in the building walking a course at a time. Each walk through


will be timed at 5 minutes. If you have multiple height dogs, please try to only walk with the first group a dog of yours is in.

- Masks are to be worn and social distancing adhered to while in the building at all times and outside when closer than 6' to another person. If you are walking your dog away from other people, or in/around your car, you may remove your mask as long as you can maintain social distancing from other competitors. Masks must be worn when running in the ring. Timer, Scribe, Ring crew, course builders and Judge shall always be masked.
- Hand sanitizer and disposable gloves will be available throughout the grounds.
- Bring your own pen to use as required. We will supply them also, but you use them at your own risk, as others may also be using them.
- The gate steward for each class will check in dogs during the walk through. There will be an additional gate sheet posted just outside the building on the right hand side that will be updated periodically during each class. Please enter using the door closest to the start of each course and exit using the door closest to the finish. We will have a speaker system outside the building so that the gate steward can make announcements about the run order status and next dogs about to run. We hope that everyone outside will be able to hear announcements, but please check the gate sheet posted outside for updates.
- Course maps for each day will be emailed to competitors the evening before. This is a full trial so may end later than usual. Please be patient, course maps will be emailed to you as soon as possible after the trial ends.
- Copies will be posted on site, there will not be any additional copies available at the trial. Judge's Class Briefings will be listed on the course maps which will be sent the night before each day of the trial. However, if you do need an explanation of anything at the trial the judge will be available to answer your question, but please maintain social distance.
- We will have a leash runner that will use a leash grabber. However, you also have the option of carrying your leash with you during a run (doesn't need to be out of sight as long as you don't lure the dog with it or use it like a toy), or you can put in your pocket or toss over the fence/towards the finish line.
- Bathrooms, entrance gates/doors, and common high touch areas will be wiped down at specific intervals throughout the day. The indoor bathrooms will be accessible, but only one toilet stall will be open, and access to indoor bathrooms will be limited to 2 people at a time. There will also be outdoor porta potties available.
- Results, labels, and ribbons will be laid out on large tables after the conclusion of each class. Title ribbons will be provided by a designated committee member. Please don't congregate at the ribbon table any longer than necessary, and please sanitize your hands prior to touching the label sheet and ribbons.
- A move up sheet will be posted by the ribbons table for next day move ups.
- If you believe there is a problem with your score, please check first with someone in the scoring area, or the Trial Secretary, to review your scribe sheet. If the problem can't be resolved there, we will arrange for you to speak with the judge.
- We will not be providing food, drinks, or a food vendor at this trial. Plan to bring what you may want for nourishment and hydration and to eat outdoors. No food that requires mask removal should be eaten inside the building. Drinks may be brought inside, but masks must remain on except while actually drinking. All food/drink must be at least 10 feet from the ring.

- We will have volunteer raffles for our great volunteer workers! They will be self serve, 2 tickets per class worke

Please check your individual confirmation carefully and let the trial secretary know immediately of any errors. Corrections that are made at the trial, regardless of who made the error, are subject to a \$5 change. During the trial, move-ups will be allowed, and must be given at the trial or emailed to the Trial Secretary via email by 7pm each day.

**General site rules:**

**Site Details:**

**The site will be open at 7AM. Please do not plan to arrive before that time.**

There are a few rules that we're asking people to follow so that we can use High Goal Farm for future trials. The pond, barn, livestock, woods, and Cerilli house are off limits to anyone at the trial. Anything else that is roped off is also off limits to anyone at the trial. There is a large field on the side of the agility building for exercising your dogs. Dogs not in the warm up area or in the ring must be leashed at all times. No smoking is allowed in the building. No alcohol or drugs are allowed at the trial site. Please clean up after yourself and your dog(s). There will be garbage receptacles for dog waste, cigarette butts, and any other garbage. Please bring water for your dogs. Crating space is limited, so please conserve space by stacking crates if possible and by using only high occupancy x-pens. Please be considerate of folks who will be crating their dogs in their vehicles by leaving the parking spaces adjacent to the building for them. Thanks in advance for complying with the above requests. In addition, please note that the building will be kept at approximately 58 degrees, so come prepared to dress in several light layers while in the building.

Judge's Class Briefings – will be listed on the course maps which will be sent the night before each day of the trial. However, if you do need an explanation of anything at the trial the judge will be available to answer your question, but please maintain social distance.

I know there is a lot of information here, and a lot of new, stricter guidelines to follow. We want everyone to be safe. But we also want EVERYONE TO HAVE FUN and to enjoy our trial held at High Goal Farm!
