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Thank you for entering the AgileDogs first CPE trial at our new property! We need to make some changes to the normal trial routine and rules due to COVID-19. We know some of these rules may be inconvenient, they are all in place to protect your safety and that of your friends/family.

First, per CPE COVID requirements and club COVID guidelines:

- Covid Waivers must be signed and returned to the club secretary prior to the start of the trial or you will not be allowed to run.
- Masks are required to be able to run. No exceptions!

Other Covid rules for this trial:

- If you are sick please stay home.
- In order to minimize potential COVID-19 exposures and stay within NYS guidelines we are limiting attendance at the trial to competitors only.
- There will be no food vendor at this trial. Please bring your own snacks, drinks, lunch. Limited bottled water will be available for volunteers.
- Masks are to be worn and social distancing adhered to while in the fenced in ring and agility ring, training building and playpen at all times. If you are in your EZ up area, walking your dog outside the fenced ring area, or in/around your car, you may remove your mask as long as you can maintain social distancing from other competitors. Masks must be worn when running in the ring. Timer, Scribe, Ring crew, course builders and Judge shall always be masked.
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the grounds.
- Bring your own pen to use as required.
- The gate steward for each class will have a clipboard. In big classes there will be split walk throughs (groups of 10) at 5 minutes long each. The gate steward will call handlers into walk and check them in when he/she does so. In these split walk throughs, the order will be walk walk run run. Please one walk per handler.
- Course maps for each day will be emailed to competitors the evening before. Copies will be posted on site, there will not be any additional copies available at the trial.
- Results stickers and ribbons will be prepared by a trial committee member and laid out on a large table in the front of the training building after the conclusion of each class. Results will be posted on the outside of the building (inside the building if inclement weather). Title ribbons will be provided by a designated committee member.

- We will not have a leash runner. You have the option of carrying your leash with you during a run (doesn't need to be out of sight as long as you don't lure the dog with it or use it like a toy), or you can put in your pocket or toss over the fence/towards the finish line.
- Porta potties, bathroom, entrance gates/doors, and common high touch areas will be wiped down throughout the day.
- Only committee members and handicapped handlers will be allowed to use the indoor bathroom in the front of the training building.

Measuring, check in, and run orders

There will be NO measuring of dogs due to COVID-19

FORMAT: One 100' X 100' ring. Electronic timing will be used. Walkthroughs will be timed at 5 minutes. Check in and setup- 7:00-7:30. Please follow the direction of our parking attendant. Space is limited

Please check your individual confirmation carefully and let the trial secretary know immediately of any errors. Corrections that are made at the trial, regardless of who made the error, are subject to a \$5 charge. During the trial, move-ups will be allowed, and must be emailed to the Trial Secretary via email by 7 pm each day.

General site rules:

This is a private residence – please respect and do not walk your dogs near/around the house or pool fenced in area behind the house. The pool area is NOT for you or your dog to swim in. If we find anyone using the pool they will be excused from the trial and no refund given.

Trash cans – will be in several locations throughout the site. There will be one blue recycle trash can, please only put recycle cans, bottles, paper and plastic in this can.

Clean up after your dogs – please!

Crating: you can set up EZ ups inside the fenced in ring, to the left of the gate. You can also set up a crate or small tent near your car if there is room (please respect your neighbor and follow the directions of our parking assistant, parking will be tight).

Judge's Class Briefings – will be listed on the course maps which will be sent the night before each day of the trial. However, if you do need an explanation of anything at the trial the judge will be available to answer your question, but please maintain social distance.

Cooling options – we will have a hose and yellow wading pool for your dogs use, and hope to also have a misting tent set up on site.

Building: the back of the building entrance/exit is to be used only by scorers and authorized people only. The front of the building can be used for entry/exit to check on and retrieve scores and ribbons. Also the bathroom for trial committee members and handicapped handlers is accessed via this entrance.

Playpen: we will allow competitor crating in the playpen, first come, first served. Please maintain social distancing.

I know this is a lot of rules. We want everyone to be safe. But we also want EVERYONE TO HAVE FUN and to enjoy the first ever trial held at AgileDogs at JAZZ!
