



Hello, Everyone!

Thank you for entering our CPE trial on September 28-29, 2019 hosted by AgileDogs Agility Training. This is your final entry confirmation. Please be sure to look at it closely and let me know of any errors or additional move ups. We are going to do our best to move the trial along efficiently while making sure everyone has a safe and successful run and gets their time in the ring. Walk throughs will be timed at 8 minutes all weekend long. Please listen to both the general briefing and the judge's class briefings for ways we can make the trial run more efficiently and for any changes to the schedule.

DAY OF SHOW

We will be taking day of show entries at this trial so if you have a friend who would like to play or you want to add to your entry-no problem. Anyone who lets me know before Thursday noon avoids paying day of show fees

DECLARED TRAINING IN THE RING WILL BE OFFERED AT THIS TRIAL:

We will offer Declared training in the ring. The handler has the option if they want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run, the handler must approach the Judge during Walkthrough or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course.

Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be TIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (this toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine its eligibility, absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring.

The following items are considered training in the ring (see Fix and Go):

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

AWARDS:

Perfect weekend rosettes will be awarded to teams achieving Q's in all 8 runs.

PARKING AND SETUP:

The Site will be open for Setup at 7:45AM Saturday and Sunday. Setup for RVs on Friday will be from 4-7PM.

Friday: There will be no check in or measuring of dogs on Friday; there will be no run throughs on Friday night.

There will be NO measuring of dogs AFTER the Judges Briefing begins each day – ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD MUST BE MEASURED before the Judges’ Briefing in order to show that day– THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.

MOVE-UPS - CLOSING DATE:

The deadline for contacting the secretary in writing with move ups or corrections before the trial is 6pm on Tuesday September 24, 2019. Any changes to entries made after that date will be subject to a \$5 service change fee, no matter who made the error.

DIRECTIONS TO BERKSHIRE COUNTY 4-H FAIRGROUNDS - .

From the Mass Pike: Take Exit 2 off the Massachusetts Turnpike and go North on Routes 20 & 7. In Lenox you will turn right off of 20 & 7 (there is a Mobil Gas Station on your right near the turn) onto Holmes Rd at a set of lights. Utility Drive is a right turn off of Holmes Rd. (There is a dark brown A framed church on the corner just after the turn to Utility Dr.)

From North of Pittsfield: Take Route 7 south through Pittsfield and cross into Lenox. Take a left in Lenox onto Holmes Rd. (You will drive through an area with many businesses on either side of the road. The left turn comes just after Essentials Day Spa on your right.) Utility Drive is a right turn off of Holmes Rd. (There is a dark brown A framed church on the corner just after the turn to Utility Dr.)
